Dear parents of Super Summer Campers,

Hello and welcome! As we begin a new and wonderful summer experience together, allow us to share some important information with you and your family.

Super Summer Camp begins on June 28<sup>th</sup> and runs through August 20<sup>th</sup>. **Camp is located at the Livingston High School, at 30 Robert Harp Dr in Livingston.** There are two parking lots on Madonna Drive. Please park your vehicle and enter through **door 12 (there's a large "Home of the Lancers" sign above the door)**, to sign your child in. Camp hours are officially 9am to 5pm, however for your convenience you may drop off your child as early as 7:15am. Pick up is no later than 6pm at the pool you selected your child to swim in. Your child needs a morning snack (optional), labeled brown bag lunch (with your child's name & grade), water bottle(s), bathing suit & towel and sneakers, daily. Flip flops, sandals, etc are not permitted at camp. In addition, Town Pool swimmers need their pool badge and a white T shirt daily. Super Summer Camp will provide a pizza lunch on Fridays; however you will still need to provide their drink.

It is very important that you label all of your child's belongings with their name and grade entering Sept 2010. Items that get separated from their owners are placed in a lost & found area at camp.

Please check our website and your emails daily, for your child's schedules, calendars, events and camp updates. Certain trips will also include lunch, so it is very important that you check our camp website & your emails daily. Website: [www.westessexymca.org](http://www.westessexymca.org)

If you have not returned your completed camp paperwork, please do so immediately. Do not jeopardize the start date of your child attending camp by not completing these items. Weekly payment in full is due the Friday before camp begins by 5pm, or your child will Not be accepted in camp on Monday morning. Thanks for your cooperation.
